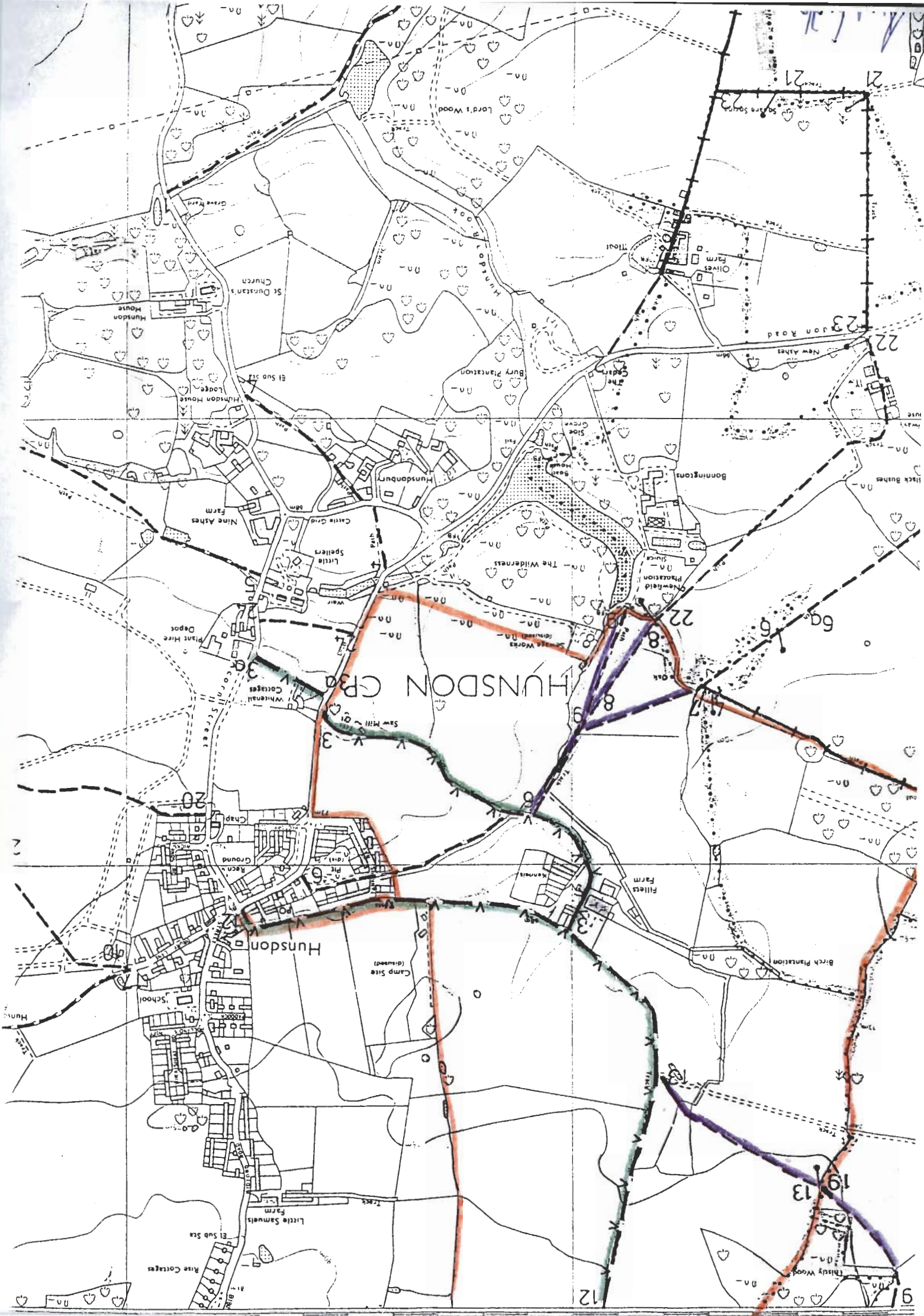

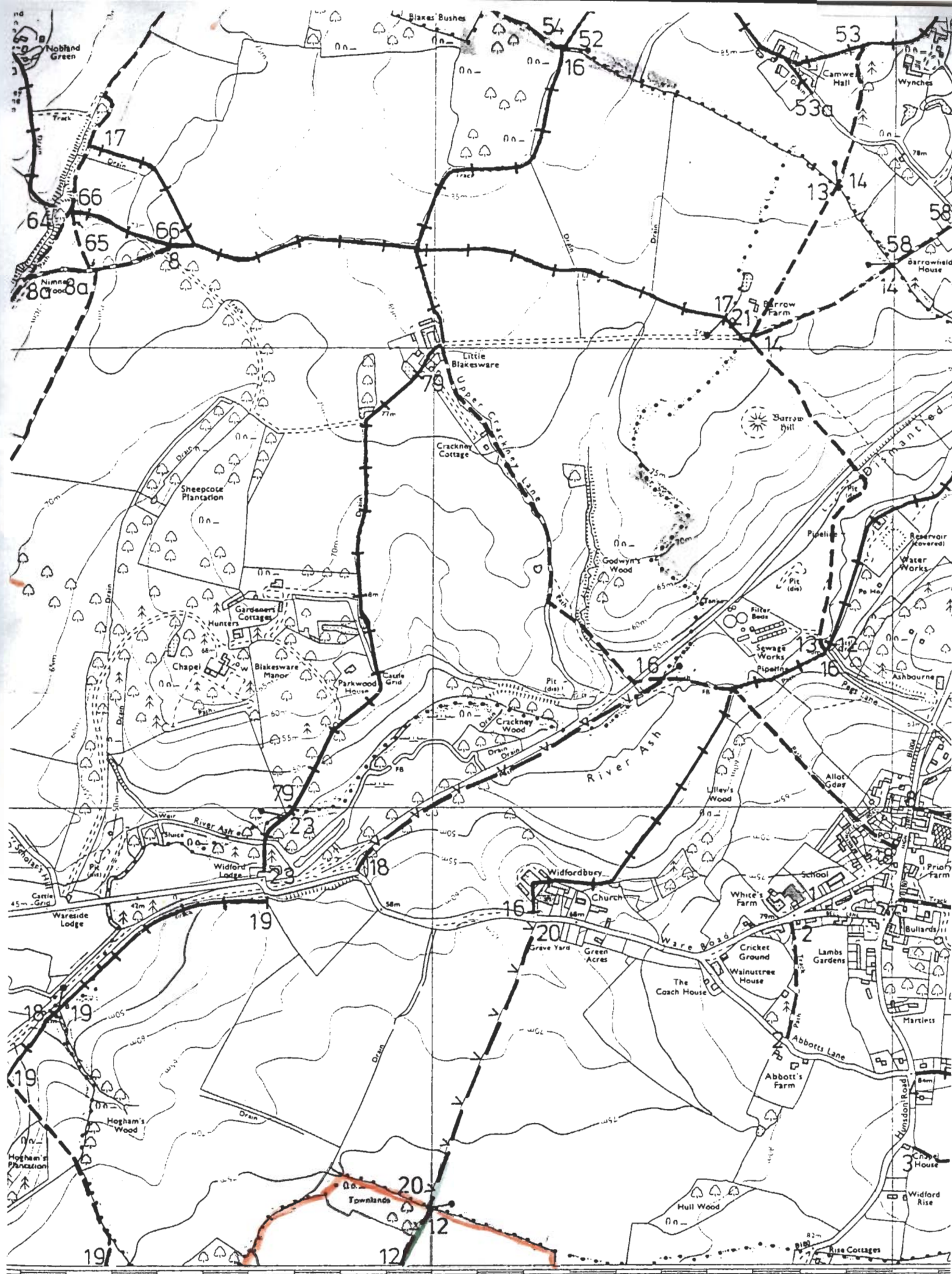

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

**WE, _____ DO SOLEMNLY
AND SINCERELY DECLARE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. We are and have been since 23 December 1994 the owners of the land known as Fillets Farm more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red. The aforementioned land lies in the Parish of Hunsdon.
2. On the 12th day of June, 1997 we deposited with Hertfordshire County Council being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said plan the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways over our property and the ways coloured purple on the said plan have been dedicated as footpaths.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 12th June 1997 referred to in 2 above marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our property.
