STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31(6) of the HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, Sandra Robertson, authorised signatory for The Chancellor, Masters and Scholars of the University of Oxford as Trustee of the Oxford Endowment Fund. DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The University are and have been since 1938 the owner of the land known as The Hoo Estate more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.
2. On the 21st day of January 1997 my predecessor in title, T del Nevo Esq, deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths, the ways coloured green on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways, the ways coloured blue on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as Restricted Byways no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. On the 19th day of the August 2002 my predecessor in title, T del Nevo Esq, deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 19th August 2002, stating that no additional ways other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths, bridleways or Restricted Byways since the deposit of the statement referred to in 2 above.
4. No additional ways have been dedicated over land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 21st January 1997 referred to in 2 above other than those footpaths, bridleways and Restricted Byways marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 17th day of June 2012 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declaration Act 1835.
