I Paul Beaumont Leach (The Chairman of the landowner, a Corporate entity) DO SOLEMNLY
DECLARE as follows

1. Leach (Brookmans) Park Limited are and have been since 1957 the owner of the land known as Land to the east of Blue Bridge Road, south east of Bluebridge Avenue, Brookmans Park, Hertfordshire more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 22nd October 2010 I deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating the property by red edging which stated that no ways had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status, bridleways or footpaths over the property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 22nd October 2010 referred to in 2. above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over the property.
