Rights-of-Way Highways Act 1980 Section 31(6)

I am writing for and on behalf of our Member, M f the  
above address, who is the freehold owner and farmer of the land forming  
Caylers Farm aforesaid.

A map defining the boundaries of Caylers Farm is attached to this letter  
and I confirm Mr. Barker acknowledges and observes the footpaths and  
rights-of-way indicated on the definitive map within the boundaries  
indicated on the map. Would you therefore please treat this letter and  
attached map as notice under Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 as  
acknowledgement that the rights-of-way shown on the current definitive  
map are public highways.

Mr. Barker is anxious to establish your formal acceptance of existing  
rights-of-way as over recent years he has established several farm tracks  
and roadways for farm and personal use. These are occasionally also used  
by friends with his consent and he is anxious these do not become  
established footpaths or public rights-of-ways. It would be helpful if  
your Council would make the position clear to the Ramblers Association  
and other organised user groups.
