

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) of the HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, A DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been since 2nd October 1998 the owner of the land known as Wood Hall Stud more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.
2. 3. * On the day 19th day of the August 2002 I [~~or my predecessor in title~~] deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 2nd August 2002 stating that no additional ways [other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] had been dedicated as [footpaths][bridleways][Byways Open to All Traffic] [Roads Used as Public Paths] since the deposit of the statement referred to in 2. above.
4. No additional ways have been dedicated over land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 2nd August 2002 referred to in 2. above [since the date of the statutory declaration referred to in 3. Above] [other than those (footpaths) (bridleways) (Byways Open to All Traffic) (Roads Used as Public Paths) marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.
