

- 3. On 15th October 2018 the Hertfordshire County Council decided not to make an Order to record as public rights of way those paths marked with blue lines on the map referred to at paragraph 1 above.
- 4. On 30th August 2019 The Planning Inspectorate allowed an Appeal against the said Order and directed the Hertfordshire County Council to make an Order under Section 53(2) and Schedule 15 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to modify the definitive map and statement to add public footpaths as marked blue as in paragraph 3 above.
