1. We The Royal Agricultural Benevolent Institution are and have been since 6th August 2010 the owner within the meaning of the above section of the land known as Moles Farm, Ware more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this statement and thereon edged red.
2. The aforementioned land lies in the Parishes of Thundridge and Wareside.
3. The ways coloured brown on the said map are recorded on the Definitive Map of Rights of Way as public highways with vehicular status.
4. The ways coloured green on the said map are recorded on the Definitive Map of Rights of Way as public bridleways.
5. The ways coloured purple on the said map are recorded on the Definitive Map of Rights of Way as public footpaths.
6. No other ways over the land have been dedicated as highways nor is it intended to dedicate any ways as public highways.
7. This Statement is made upon the basis of information contained within the Definitive Map and Statement as at the date of this statement and is without prejudice to my position in the event of the discovery of evidence as to the status of any of the said ways as provided for within Section 53 (3) (c) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

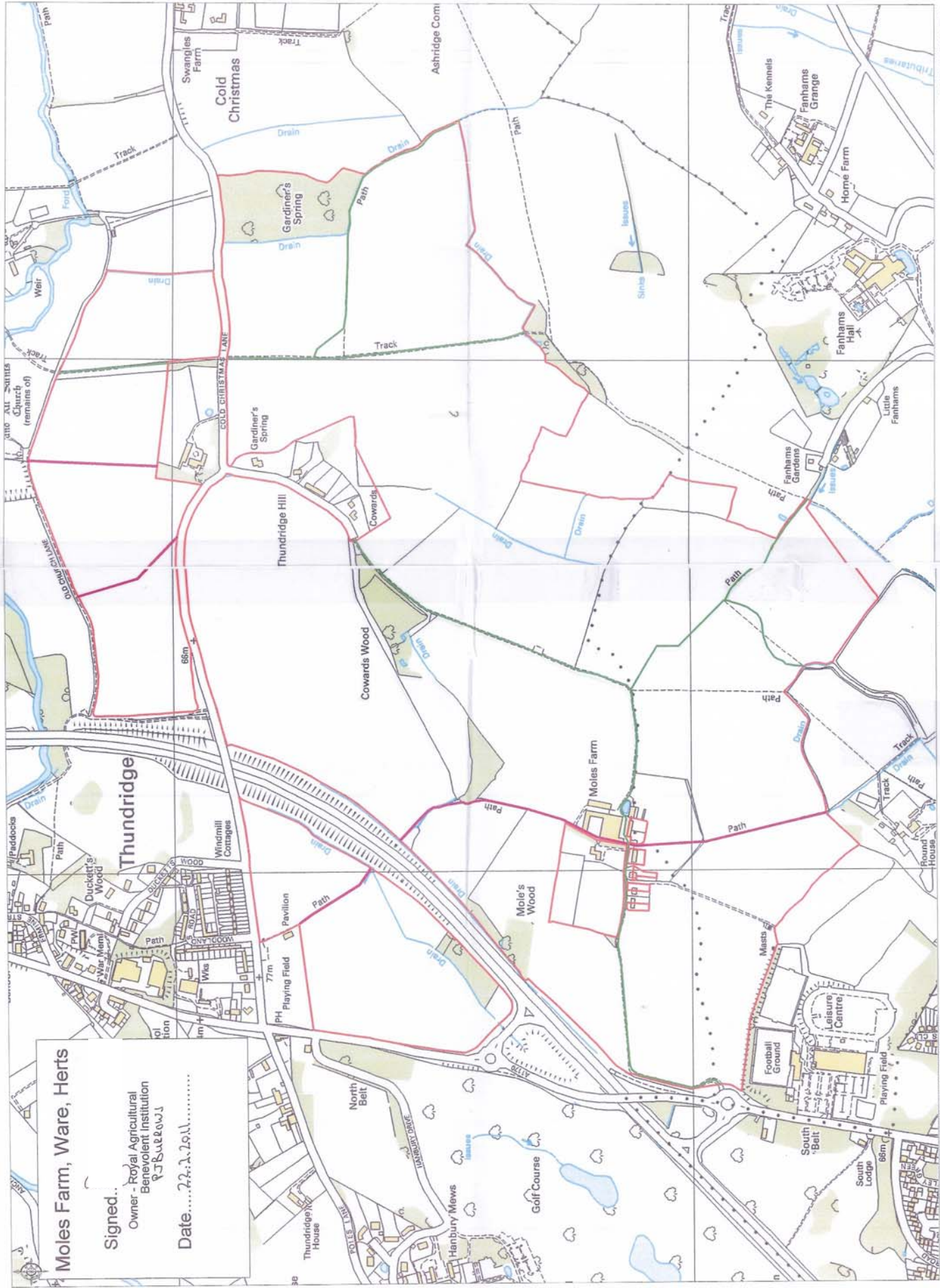

**STATUTORY DECLARATION MADE UNDER
SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

We, The Royal Agricultural Benevolent Institution, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY
DECLARE as follows:

1. We are, and have been since 6th August 2010, the owners within the meaning of the above section of the land known as Moles Farm, Ware, more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On 28th January 2011 we deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating our property by red edging which stated that the way coloured green on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration are recorded on the Definitive Map of Rights of Way as public bridleways and the ways coloured purple on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration are recorded on the Definitive Map of Rights of Way as public footpaths. No other ways have been added as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the Statement dated 4th January 2011 referred to in 2. above and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over our land.
