DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are and have been since 14/11/1983 the owners of the land known as Walkern Hall Farms more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.

2. On the Fifth day of December 2000 We deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that [the way(s) coloured purple or annotated and labelled with reference to the key on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpath(s)*] [the way(s) coloured green or annotated and labelled with reference to the key on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as ~~as~~ bridleway(s)*] the way(s) coloured brown or annotated and labelled with reference to the key on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as Byway(s) Open to All Traffic*] [[no [other] ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.]

3. On the Sixth day of December 2000 We deposited with Hertfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 28/11/2000, stating that no additional ways [other than those marked in the appropriate colour or annotated and labelled with reference to the key on the plan accompanying this declaration] had been dedicated as [footpath(s)] [bridleway(s)] [Restricted Byway(s)] [Byway(s) Open to All Traffic] since the deposit of the statement referred to in 2 above. *

4. No additional ways have been dedicated over land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 5/12/2000 referred to in 2 above [since the date of the statutory declaration referred to in 3 above] [other than those (footpaths) (bridleways) (Restricted Byways) (Byways Open to All Traffic) marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.
