

DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT AND PLAN  
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

1. The Major R A F Page Croft Children and Grandchildren's 1981 Trust is the owner of the land known as the North Ware land between High Oak Road, Round House, the Woodson Centre and North Ware more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this statement and thereon edged in red. The property known as Round House is not included in the land that is the subject of this statement.
2. The present Trust has owned the land since 1989. A meeting of the Trustees held on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2009 authorised \_\_\_\_\_ to make this deposit.
3. The aforementioned land lies in the Parishes of Wareside and Ware Town.
4. The ways coloured purple on the said plan have been dedicated as footpaths
5. The ways coloured green on the said plan have been dedicated as bridleways
6. The roads known as High Oak Road and Fanhams Hall Road labelled as such on the plan accompanying this statement have been dedicated as public vehicular highways.
7. No other ways over the land have been dedicated as highways
8. The deposit shall comprise this statement and accompanying plan
