Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognizes that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
  - c. Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognizes the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
  - d. Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint, the Secretary of State recognizes the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.

Of the above highways, those described in sub-paragraphs "a", "b" and "c" are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council under the provision of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, as amended by the Countryside Act 1968. The routes indicated by paragraph "d" are more particularly described in detail on Plan No Extract attached.




