
- 1. I am directed to deposit with you, under the provisions of Sub-Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 the enclosed plan/plans numbered Heats. - 2. Your attention is particularly drawn to the legend on the plan, and I am to confirm that the extent of public rights recognised by the Secretary of State for Defence over each route shown on the plan is as follows:
 - (a) Over each route shown by continuous purple line, the Secretary of State recognises a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
 - (b) Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognises that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
 - (c) Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognises the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths or bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
 - (d) Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint the Secretary of State recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.






