Commences from the N side of Great Ashby Way at TL 25840 27340 thence generally W to TL 25760 27370 and thence N to TL 25760 27460 and thence generally E to TL 25850 27510 and thence generally N to TL 25860 27560 S of Cromdale Walk, thence generally NE and N to parish boundary and the junction with Weston 46 at TL 25930 27680

**Width** 1.8 metres between TL 25840 27340 and TL 25850 27510  
3 metres between TL 25860 27560 and TL 25930 27620  
5 metres between TL 25930 27620 and TL 25930 27680

**Limitations** None between TL 25840 27340 and TL 25930 27680

Commences from junction with FP13a and BR19 (Botany Bay Lane, also known as Stevenage 102) at TL 2606 2708 thence generally NE across Great Ashby Way, continuing NE to parish boundary at northern corner of wood thence into Weston Parish towards Dane End.

**Width** Minimum 4m from its junction with FP13a for a distance of approx 40 metres

Commences at a point on the parish boundary between Stevenage and Great Ashby (formerly Graveley) immediately to the W of Great Ashby Way at TL 2635 2669 thence generally S for approx 40m along the parish boundary to a point on the W boundary of Great Ashby Way at TL 2636 2665. Continues from E boundary of same road at TL 2639 2666 thence generally E along N side of Box Wood to parish boundary at NE corner of Box Wood. (The part along the parish boundary is also known as FP101 Stevenage.)

**Width** Minimum 2m between TL 2635 2669 and TL 2636 2665

Commences at junction with BR12 and BR19 (Botany Bay Lane, also known as Stevenage 102) thence SE to SW corner of Hangbois Spring.

Commences from the end of the vehicular length of Botany Bay Lane (5U239) (at TL 25495 27375) thence eastwards and southwards to the northern edge of Great Ashby Way (at TL 25565 27315). Recommences at the southern edge of Great Ashby Way (at TL 25580 27295) thence generally south eastwards to junctions with FP11 Graveley (at TL 25800 27125) and FP91 Stevenage (at TL 25840 27105), thence continuing eastwards to a junction with BR12 and FP13a Great Ashby (formerly Graveley) (at TL 26060 27080) and another junction with Great Ashby Way at TL 26075 27080). This route is also known as Stevenage 102.

**Width** Between 5m and 18m as shown hatched on the plan forming part of the Hertfordshire County Council (Stevenage 102 and Graveley 19) Legal Event Modification Order 2000

Commences at Great Ashby (formerly Graveley) BR 12 at TL 2654 2731 then round the E side of the playground then generally SE through Claypithills Spring (to the junction with former Weston 47 at the former parish boundary (TL 2664 2711)) then generally S to TL 2665 2691 then generally E and SE around the E side of the recreation ground to TL 2695 2678 then generally SW to the former parish boundary and Great Ashby (formerly Graveley) FP 13 at TL 2688 2666

**Width** A minimum of 2 metres between TL 2654 2731 and TL 2688 2666
