001 FP HCC 79

Commences from south side of The Ridgeway opposite 'Hanyards' thence SW, W and SW to Vineyards Road adjacent to Carramore House.

Commences from SE corner of Home Wood on W side of Tolmers Road thence generally N through Wood to Carbone Hill S of Postern Bridge.

Commences from between 49 and 51 Tolmers Road thence W to Kingsmead between Nos. 18 and 20.

Commences from county road opposite Northaw House Lodge thence generally W to parish boundary W of Northaw Place.

Commences from Well Road S of Queenswood School Lodge thence NE to Griffin's Hole in Well Wood.

Commences at junction with Northaw Road East thence SE across railway thence S, SW and E to connect to FP59 (Cheshunt) SE of Soper's Viaduct.

Hook Lane, commences at a junction with Northhaw 16 at TL 2802 0181 running generally south west for approximately 535 metres to a junction with the northern end of the Hook Cottages access road at TL 2771 0138. Continuing generally south west for approximately 190 metres to a junction with Coopers Lane Road at TL 2759 0124.

Width 2.8m at TL 2802 0181 4 metres from TL 2802 0181 to TL 2772 0139 2.7 metres from TL 2772 0139 to TL 2771 0138 4 metres from TL 2771 0138 to TL 2759 0124

Commences from Homewood Avenue thence NE to Brookside Crescent.

Commences from junctions of FP's 14 and 16 at the parish boundary thence NE between hedge and barbed wire fence 6' wide to stile. Continuing NE across rough open pasture 6' wide well defined to junctions of FP's 49 and 4 at parish boundary.

Starts at the M25 and County Boundary and runs northwards in an enclosed lane to emerge by way of a stile in the hedgerow at Coopers Lane Road about 270 yards east of the entrance to Barvins Park opposite.

Commences at Coopers Lane Road approx. 250 yards south east of Chequers Mead and runs southwards between hedge and wire fence for approx. 150 yards. Thence south along a farm track with a wood and then a wooded gully to the west. At the foot of the hill crosses cart bridge and continues south along track to the M25 and County Boundary.

Commences from Northhaw 6 at TL 3070 0164 thence generally north west along farm track to Soper's Viaduct. From Soper's Viaduct follow the farm track round and generally south to TL 3056 0168 then south following the railway boundary fence to TL 3054 0151, thence south west to Cattlegate Farm at TL 3041 0092. Proceeds south-west between farm buildings then bears right and then left to follow farm road south-westwards to end at Cattlegate Road.

Width 4 metres between TL 3070 0164 and TL 3044 0099. 6m between TL 3044 0099 and TL 3054 0151. 8m between TL 3054 0151 and TL 3056 0168. 4m between TL 3056 0168 and TL 3041 0092.
