THE HERTFORDSHIRE (BOAT 40, ASHLYNS UNDERPASS, BERKHAMSTED)
(HEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1993

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 199 and may be cited as "The Hertfordshire, (BOAT 40, Ashlyns Underpass, Berkhamsted) (Height Restriction) Order 1993."
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the height of a vehicle is the distance between the ground and the point on the vehicle or any load being carried by, or any equipment which is fitted to, the said vehicle, which is furthest from the ground.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle the height of which exceeds 2.67 metres (8 ft 9 inches) to enter or proceed along that length of BOAT (Byway open to all traffic) 40 Berkhamsted from a point 150 metres south east of the junction with Ashlyns Hall access road southwards for a distance of approximately 30 metres under the A41 Berkhamsted By-Pass.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE HERTFORDSHIRE (BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC 40, ASHLYNS UNDERPASS, BERKHAMSTED) (HEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1993

Where BOAT 40 passes under the Berkhamsted Bypass a structure with only limited headroom has been constructed. The BOAT is in law open to all traffic, and a height restriction prohibiting vehicles over 2.67 metres (8ft 9ins) in height is required for the length of road under the Bypass.
