**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC (BOAT) 101,
HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1993**

The Hertfordshire County Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3), 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicles (as defined in Section 138(1) of the Act of 1984) to proceed along Byway open to all traffic (BOAT) 101 Hemel Hempstead from a point 30 metres south of its junction with Roughdown Avenue south westwards for an approximate distance of 450 metres to its junction with Footpath 99, Hemel Hempstead.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along BOAT 101 if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those lengths of road for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those lengths of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those lengths of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those lengths of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those lengths of road or any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (d) in the service of a local authority or a statutory water undertaker or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
