 - (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance improvement or reconstructions of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
 - in any emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (e) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers of duties.
