THE BOROUGH OF DACORUM (VARIOUS ROADS, TRING)

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1987

The Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under s.101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under s.1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads referred to in that article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those roads;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance improvement or reconstructions of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
 - (d) in any emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (e) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 14 September 1987 and may be cited as "the Borough of Dacorum (Various Roads, Tring)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1987".

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1988

The Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under s.101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under s.1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the road specified in the Schedule to this Order, *during the period 1 November to 30 April each year.*

Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads referred to in that article if the vehicle is being used:-

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those roads;
- (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
- (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance improvement or reconstructions of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (d) in any emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (e) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.



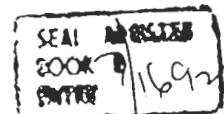

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the road specified in the Schedule to this Order, during the period 1 November to 30 April each year.

Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in any of the roads referred to in that article if the vehicle is being used:-

- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those roads;
- (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those roads or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
- (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those roads, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those roads, the maintenance improvement or reconstructions of those roads, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to those roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (d) in any emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (e) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

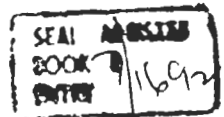
