**Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire
Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)**

This statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 19 (B) (ii) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and gives notice of the adoption of the County Council's Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

The Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire SPD forms part of the County's Minerals and Waste Development Framework (MWDF). It identifies areas of the County where particular care is needed to prevent the unnecessary sterilisation of sand and gravel resources, and to explain the way in which the County and District/Borough Councils will work together to protect the resources in those areas.

Any person(s) aggrieved by the Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire SPD may apply to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months of the date of this notice.

Copies of The Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire SPD are available for public inspection at County Hall, Pegs Lanes, Hertford, free of charge on Mondays to Fridays between 9am to 5pm, and at your local District/Borough Council office – please contact their offices for opening hours.

The Mineral Consultation Areas in Hertfordshire SPD can also be viewed at all libraries within Hertfordshire and on the County Council's web site www.hertsdirect.org. It is also available on CDROM upon request.
