


Indicative risk scores for ordinary watercourses linked to the consultation on Hertfordshire County Council draft service standards (Map 6 of 10)



The depiction of ordinary watercourses on this map is based on the best currently available Hertfordshire wide data-sets. Not all ordinary watercourses may be shown and some alignments may be incorrectly mapped especially where watercourses in built-up areas are extensively culverted. As the definition of an ordinary watercourse is based on a physical description rather than being dependant on being documented they, unlike main rivers, may not all be mapped. The record of ordinary watercourses will be updated as errors and omissions are notified or discovered. The status of watercourses may change over time if for example they are added to or removed from the map of Main Rivers maintained by the Environment Agency
