

Road Closures and Lane Closures

Improvements to the layout of the A412 Denham Way at its junction with Chalfont Road

Dear Resident,

We are writing to tell you about some works we'll be undertaking in your area.

We understand these works may be an inconvenience to you, however, we ask you to support us as we make the necessary improvements.

The layout of the A412 Denham Way and Chalfont Road is to be improved, the junction of the A412/Chalfont Road/Maple Lodge Close resurfaced and the existing traffic signals refurbished.

Work is programmed to commence on the 25th January 2021 for 18 weeks.

To create a safe working environment for the workforce and members of the public alike, the works will be carried out with the following traffic management.

Junction improvements and Traffic Signals refurbishment – 25th January 2021 for 18 weeks

- Northbound lane of A412 Denham Way to be closed either side of the junction with Chalfont Road, vehicle access will be maintained by the use of three-way temporary traffic signals on Denham Way and Maple Lodge Close. On completion of work on the western side of A412 Denham Way the lane closure will switch to the Southbound lane.
- Chalfont Road is to be closed from its junction with Oakhill Close to the A412 Denham Way. Vehicles will be diverted via Hornhill Road and Woodland Road.

Vehicle access to Oakhill Close will be maintained by the use of 2-way temporary traffic signals at the junction of Chalfont Road and Oakhill Close. Entry to Crosslands and surrounding properties will be via A412 Denham Way and Chalfont Road, exit will be via the Northern end of Denham Way service road.

- Denham Way Service Road (West) is to be closed at its junction with Chalfont Road. Access is to be maintained via the southern end of the service road.

Surfacing Works – 19th May 2021 for 6 nights

- A412 Denham Way to be closed – Access into and out of Maple Lodge Close will be maintained.
- Chalfont Road closed at its junction with Oakhill Close. Vehicles will be diverted via Hornhill Road and Woodland Road.

The working hours are described in the table below;

Some degree of disruption and delay can be expected as a result of these works and whilst we will make every effort to minimise these please allow extra time for any journeys you may make while these works are in progress. We greatly appreciate your patience and co-operation.

What you need to know:

- *We would like to reassure residents that we are following Government advice relating to construction works and guidelines regarding social distancing to minimise the risks related to Covid-19 (Coronavirus).*
- We politely request that all residents respect our workforce and follow social distancing guidelines when passing the works area or engaging with our on-site team.
- **Vehicles may not be allowed access through the road closure during the works, except for emergency vehicles. We are unable to provide information on which part of the road will have access and when. Please speak to the on-site team on the day who will be able to advise on this.**
- Please refer to the yellow signboards at either end of your street to see the exact dates, timings and permit number. Any date changes to these works will be communicated on these yellow signboards and at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadclosures
- These works are weather dependent and may be postponed if poor weather is forecast.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works and all local businesses will be open as usual.
