Local Transport Plan 4 (LTP4) Update

This paper is for information only, setting out a brief update on the production of the new LTP4 and expected timescales prior to adoption.

1. LTP4 DEVELOPMENT FOLLOWING TRANSPORT VISION CONSULTATION

A 3 month public consultation on the emerging content of LTP4 was held from September - December 2016. A report on the feedback from this consultation exercise will be considered by the county council's Environment, Planning and Transport (EPT) Cabinet Panel on 30 June 2017.

Since 2016 the further development of the new LTP4 has focussed primarily on addressing issues raised during the consultation exercise and the following three areas:

- **Policy Review:** A policy review exercise of existing LTP3 policies was undertaken producing changes and recommendations for new policy wording with stronger alignment to the LTP4 objectives.
- **Strategic Corridor Narratives:** Work was undertaken to analyse key corridors in the county and identify strategic narratives for these, outlining planned major schemes and interventions.
- **Future Hertfordshire Scenarios:** An assessment of the Strategy against various future transport supply and demand scenarios. Conclusions from this have been used to improve our appreciation of future uncertainties and drivers of change implications, and make the LTP4 strategy more robust and adaptable.

The above work is now complete. The final drafting of the LTP4 is being finalised and subject to internal review and refinement.
