NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council in order to improve road safety proposes under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce new waiting restrictions, a 20 mph zone in St Albans and a new 30mph speed limit in part of Cottonmill Lane, St Albans as specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Notice.

It is also proposed under sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with The Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, to install flat topped road humps in those lengths of Cottonmill Lane, St Albans as specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice.

- (c) from a point 12 metres north west of a point in line with the projected north west kerbline of Monks Close north westwards for 8.5 metres.
- (d) from a point 7.5 metres south east of a point in line with the boundary between 65 and 65a Cottonmill Close south eastwards for 8.5 metres.
- (e) From a point 7 metres north of a point in line with the boundary between 87 and 89 Cottonmill Lane northwards for 8.5 metres.

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Cottonmill Lane, St Albans) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2024" and shall come into effect on
- 2. The Hertfordshire (Cottonmill Lane, St Albans) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2024 Plan numbered **SA00124 WR** (the "waiting restrictions plan") as listed in the Schedule to this Order is incorporated into this Order.

3. Interpretation -

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"postal packet" shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

"provision of a universal postal Service" shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

"universal service provider" shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

"waiting restrictions plan" is the plan numbered **SA00124 WR** inclusive of its key, which is incorporated into this Order as set out in Article 2 and the Schedule;

- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on areas of road or sides of the road as shown on the waiting restrictions plan, where waiting is not allowed as identified and shown on the waiting restrictions plan and its key thereof.
- 5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order applies in relation to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform, or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by St Albans City & District Council.
 - (c) a vehicle which is being used for one or more of the following purposes and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose;

- (i) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
- (iv) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
- (v) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- (d) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is waiting only for long as is reasonably necessary to enable postal packets to be delivered or collected.
- 6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area" so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary
 - (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area or
 - (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage
- 7. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road restricted by that Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- 8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 9. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order:

ROAD HUMP (VERULAM ROAD, HITCHIN) 2024

Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce new waiting restrictions, a 20 mph zone in St Albans and a new 30mph speed limit in part of Cottonmill Lane, St Albans.

The proposals will comprise of -

- No waiting at any time restrictions on parts of Cottonmill Lane.
- A 20 mph zone on those lengths of Pondwicks Close, Holywell Hill, Grove Road, London Road Car Park / Hart Road, London Road, Watling Street, Coningsby Bank, Howland Garth, Kempe Close, Ashby Gardens, Ashdales, Holyrood Crescent, Creighton Avenue, Mitchell Close, Deacon Close, Martyr Close, Lectern Lane, Butterfield Lane, Nuns Lane, Gorham Drive, Cloister Garth, Abbots Avenue, Abbots Avenue West, Chapel Close, Norman Close, Wallingford Walk, Grindcobbe, Trumpington Drive, Berners Drive, Priory Walk, Maynard Drive, Pemberton Close, Cyrils Way, Hudson Close, Watling View, Tavistock Avenue, Tavistock Close, Vesta Avenue, Praetorian Court, Monks Close, Doggetts Way, Fernecroft, Orient Close, Butt Field View, Mercers Row, Wilshere Avenue, Old Oak, Everard Close, Griffiths Way, Graham Close, Boleyn Drive, Sadleir Road, Mentmore Road, Nunnery Close, Leyland Avenue, St Julian's Road, Prospect Road, Cottonmill Lane, Nunnery Stables, Old Sopwell Gardens, Tithe Barn Close, Robert Avenue, Gillian Avenue and Warren Road.
- A 30mph speed limit on parts of Cottonmill Lane.
- Raised speed tables / flat topped road humps on parts of Cottonmill Lane.

The no waiting at any times restrictions are proposed only at locations where the implementation of build outs and pedestrian crossings require parking to be restricted to ensure safe flow of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians).


The proposals aim to introduce a lower speed limit, thereby reducing the likely potential of injury accidents and create an environment to encourage more walking and cycling. Road humps are being installed to ensure compliance with 20 mph. A new 30mph speed limit would create a buffer zone between sections of National Speed Limit and 20 mph.

The reduction of the speed limit, to that of a 20mph zone, aligns to Hertfordshire County Councils Speed Management Strategy.

The traffic calming features are located so as not to restrict vehicular access to properties.

Therefore, having also considered the duty imposed under Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, it appears to the Highway Authority that it is necessary and expedient to make an Order in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).


