

True or False Library Quiz - Key Stage 1 – with answers

1. You can borrow up to 15 library books at a time
False: You can borrow up to 30 books at a time, which is A LOT of books to carry home (you might want to check with your parents before you borrow 30 books)
2. It costs £5 to join the library
False: It is free to join the library. It's free to borrow books, too.
3. There are 46 libraries in Hertfordshire
True: There are 46 public libraries in Hertfordshire. There is also a Performing Arts Library, which lends music to choirs and orchestras, and playscripts to actors. There's an archive, too, which has lots of amazing historical documents like maps and diaries.
4. You need your library card to return books
False: You can return your books at the kiosk with having to show your library card
5. You have to be 12 years old to use the computers in the library
False: Anyone can use the library computers, but children must have permission from their parent or guardian
6. You can use the computer for free for one hour a day
True: Library members are entitled to one hour free on a library computer every day
7. You can use your library card at every public library in Hertfordshire
True: If you have a library card you can use it at all 46 libraries in Hertfordshire
8. Children have their own area in every public library
True: Every public library has a children's area, and in some libraries the children's area even has a separate room of its own.
9. You have to be able to read to join the library
False: You don't have to be able to read to join the library. Everyone can join the library, even babies! Libraries have special Baby Rhyme Times for babies and their grown-ups. You might have gone to one when you were a baby.
10. You can borrow books for three weeks
True and False! You can borrow a book for three weeks, but if you want to borrow it for longer (and nobody else needs it) you can ask to keep it for another three weeks.
11. You can choose your own book
True: Yes, you can. And, if you can't decide which book you want, the librarian can help you find one.
