Re: The Henrietta Barnett School Admissions Consultation

The Governors of The Henrietta Barnett School wish to consult on changes to the Admissions Policy for Entry in 2021-22.

The full Admissions Policy for Consultation is attached with this letter and can be found on the School Website in the Admissions section.

Other than improved wording for clarification in various places (for example if there are tied scores at the cut-off point after Round One, all those on that score will be invited to sit Round Two), the key changes are as follows:

For Year 7 admissions:

- 1) Pupil Admission Number (PAN) moved up from 100 to 104 (to reflect the fact that 104 students have been offered places in Year 7 in recent years).
- 2) Removed mention of "Bands A, B, C" and a simpler way found to give parents information before they make decisions and complete their Local Authority CAF forms in October.

For Year 12 Admissions:

- 3) Specific languages only are listed as GCSE subjects to be scored for entry, where previously any languages were acceptable.
- 4) Students wishing to study Chemistry A level must have a grade 8 or 9 in Chemistry GCSE.
