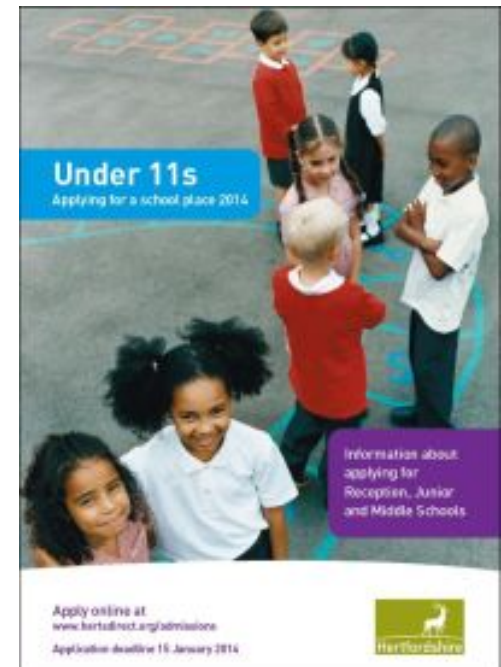

Admission oversubscription criteria (rules) for primary schools that use Hertfordshire County Council’s admission criteria are given below.

Admissions Criteria for Community and Voluntary-Controlled schools	
SEN	Children with a statement of special educational needs naming the school
CLA	Children in public care. This rule applied to children looked after and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a residence order or a special guardianship order).
Social/ Medical	Children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school.
Siblings	Children who have a sibling on the roll of the school or linked school at the time of application. <i>This applies to reception through to Year 5 in infant, junior and primary schools; and from reception through to Year 3 in first schools; and from Year 5 to Year 7 in middle schools</i>
Nearest School	Children for whom it is their nearest community or voluntary-controlled school or an own admitting school or academy using Hertfordshire’s admission rules.
Not Nearest School	Children who live nearest to the school.
