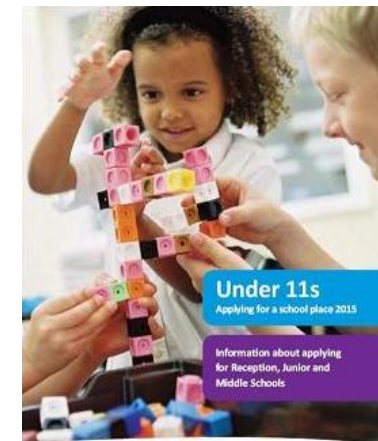

SEN	Children with a statement of special educational needs or education, health and care plan naming the school.
CLA	Children looked after and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or a special guardianship order).
Social/Medical	Children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school.
Linked Infant	Children who attend the linked infant school at the time of their application <i>Note: This rule only applies to pupils who are currently attending an infant school which has a linked junior school.</i>
Siblings	Children who have a sibling on the roll of the school or linked school at the time of application. <i>Note: This applies to reception through to Year 5 in infant, junior and primary schools; and from reception through to Year 3 in first schools; and from Year 5 to Year 7 in middle schools.</i>
