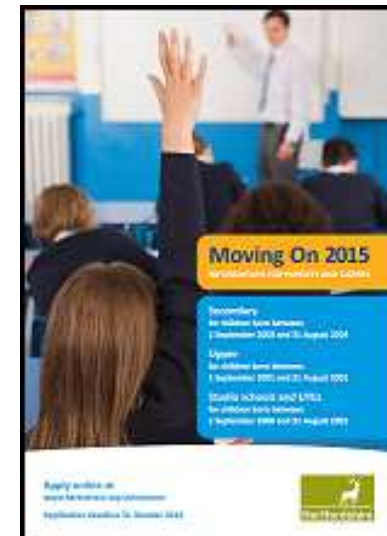

NOTES

- We do not hold allocation information for applicants living outside Hertfordshire unless they have been allocated a Hertfordshire Secondary/Upper school. Therefore the number of ranked allocations plus the number of non-ranked allocations may not always equal the number of applicants. For the same reason a school with only ranked allocations may not show as 100% ranked.
- In the 'Non Ranked Allocation' columns the first figures refer to the **total** number of non ranked allocations or percentage, while the figures in brackets refer to the number of **ontime** non ranked allocations or percentage.
