<b>Social/Medical</b>	Children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school, which includes children previously from abroad who were cared for by the state because he or she would not otherwise have been cared for adequately and subsequently adopted.
<b>Linked Infant</b>	Children who attend the linked infant school at the time of their application <i>Note: This rule only applies to pupils who are currently attending an infant school which has a linked junior school.</i>
