Tudor Way is a distinctive new development which forms part of the wider £30m regeneration of the Sele Farm Estate in Hertford. Designed to replace a subsiding block of 1950s flats, the development comprises 11 terraced three bedroom family homes and 24 one and two bedroom apartments with communal gardens. The contemporary design and elegant frontage is a modern take on a Bath terrace and is spread across multiple

levels to provide stylish, contemporary living for families and individuals. Sustainable features and recycled materials feature heavily within the development, including a sedum roof and a sustainable surface water system, which reduces the amount of hardstanding surface areas.
