Registration:

To access iLearn+ it requires you to register. Registration will help us identify your area of access.

If you are an Authorised User, who is an individual subscriber, your registration will give you access to the full range of learning modules on the site. Registration details are available on the site here: https://hertfordshire.learningpool.com/login/signup.php. No payment will be taken unless you choose to become an Authorised User and agree to these terms of references.

As part of signing up to iLearn+ you agree to use the site only for lawful purposes and in a way that does not infringe the rights of, restrict or inhibit anyone else's use and enjoyment of, iLearn+.
