Experts by Experience	You said: We do not always get to be included in our annual review and when we do it is not always clear why we are there.	Young people across Hertfordshire and their families often discussed confusion over annual reviews and the involvement of the child / young person. One young person said that whenever they had an annual review they felt like 'my life was being dissected and I was not sure why I was there or if I was being heard.' 
